
NEW HAVEN COUNTY



The Area

New Haven is the home of the Ivy League institution, Yale University and its renowned health care system. Both are an integral part of the city's economy, as well as being New Haven's biggest taxpayer and employer. New Haven had the first public tree planting program in America, producing a canopy of mature trees, including some large elms, which gave New Haven the nickname "The Elm City." Many of the city's neighborhoods are well-preserved as walk-able museums of 19th and 20th century American architecture, particularly by the New Haven Green, Hillhouse Avenue and other residential sections close to Downtown New Haven. The New Haven Green is the site of many free music concerts such as the New Haven Symphony Orchestra, the July Free Concerts on the Green and the New Haven Jazz Festival.
